## MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT:

I think the neighborhood has done its share to support Pokeman-Go and need to share the fun with other neighborhoods. The FSAA Board of Directors voted 17 to 1 to ask the city to remove some of the Pokeman stops from the Pagoda. Most places have ONE stop, we have FOUR and that is what drives the 2000 folks a day we see at the Pagoda, including 250 at 0300 in the morning! The Police Department, Parks and Recs, and Councilwoman McClellan have all submitted requests to do so. They also asked that the game time end at 10PM when the Park closes. However, it took a month for the City to get NianticOps to remove the stops from our Historic Cemeteries, but they finally did.

Town Point Park and Nauticus have some Pokestops and gyms and are already popular places to play the game. Holly Christopher, Parks and Rec will take a walk through the park and identify any new locations that would serve the participants.

## Virginia Bike Safety Tips from VADOT

### Rights and Duties

Every person riding a bicycle on a highway shall be subject to the provisions of the Code of Virginia section on motor vehicles and shall have the rights and duties applicable to the driver of a vehicle unless a provision clearly indicates otherwise.

Bicyclists and other users on sidewalks, shared use paths, and crosswalks have all the rights and duties of a pedestrian under the same circumstance.

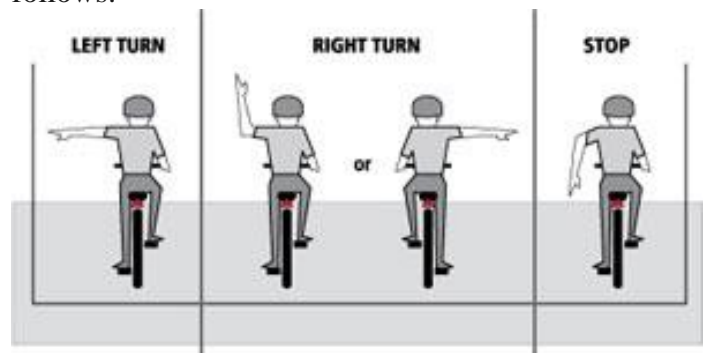
### Traffic Controls

Bicyclists must obey all traffic signs, signals, lights, and markings. Under certain circumstances bicyclists, motorcycles, and mopeds may proceed through a solid red light at an intersection. A driver or rider may proceed through the intersection on a steady red light only if the driver or rider complies with all five provisions listed below:

1. Comes to a full and complete stop at the intersection for two complete cycles of the traffic light or for two minutes, whichever is shorter
2. Exercises due care as provided by law
3. Otherwise treats the traffic control device as a stop sign
4. Determines that it is safe to proceed
5. Yields the right of way to the driver of any vehicle approaching on such other highway from either direction.

### Changing Directions

Bicyclists must signal their intentions to stop or turn. The proper signals are made with the left arm as follows:



A right turn may be signaled with the right arm. The signals do not have to be given continuously if both hands are needed to control the bicycle.
